

## ARRA BLOCK GRANT STATE APPLIANCE REBATE PROGRAMS

Generally, Energy Star rated appliances are eligible for rebates. However, many states have additional energy efficiency requirements. Please check with the particular state to determine what appliances are eligible for rebates. Also, most states require that the purchaser be a resident of the state, and that the appliance be purchased from a retailer located within the state. A few states also have specific income and other requirements.
