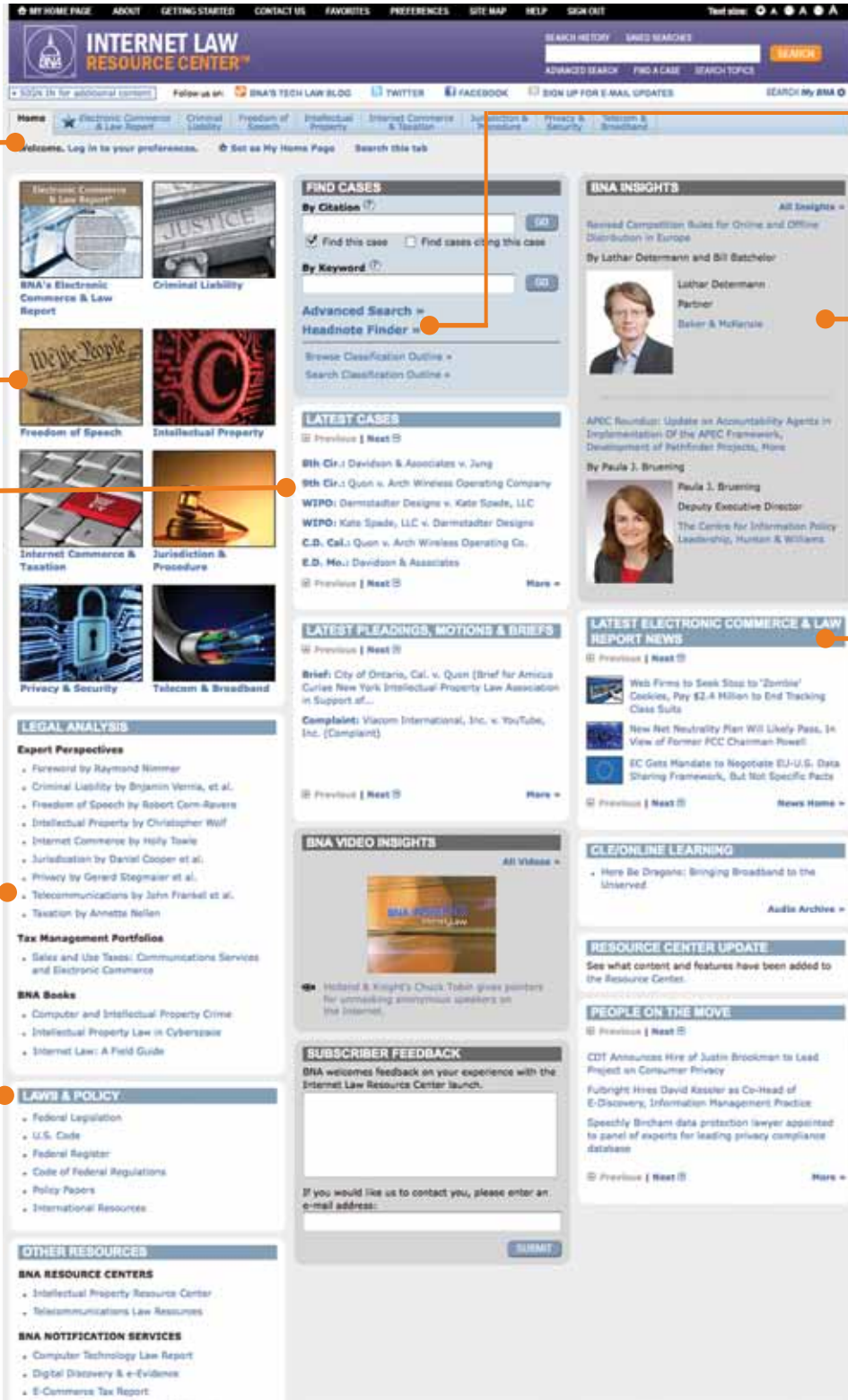

Headnote Finder

To review all headnotes on a specific topic:

1. Select appropriate **classification outline**.
2. Select specific topic tied to a **classification number**.
3. **After reviewing all headnotes, limit review:**
 - By **court**
 - By **key words or phrases** in the headnotes
 - By **date**
4. Click **Search**.

If you need help finding the right classification number, return to the **Find Cases** box in the center of the Home Page or one of the Topic Pages, and click on Browse or Search **Alphabetical Index** or **Classification Outline**.

1. To search internet cases and decisions, select **Advanced Search** either from the link in the banner, or from the "Search this tab" link near the top of the topical home pages.
2. Choose the selections you want to search.
3. Make sure you are searching the appropriate content.
4. If not, **edit** selections.
5. Enter words or phrases.
6. Use **Search Operators**.
7. Limit searches to specific fields, if desired.
8. Restrict search by **date**, if desired.
